Arabic:

The students at Iqra Elementary School learn to read, write, speak and understand Arabic language as part of our school's special character. We use innovative ways to teach Arabic to our students. Two able teachers Mrs. Ghada and Mrs. Reem incorporate and integrate Arabic learning with school wide theme. Mrs. Reem teaches Year 1 and 2 and Mrs. Ghada teaches Year 3, 4 and 5. We are extremely proud of our students' achievements.

Room 1: Year 0-1

In Room one we have been enjoying the topic "About me". Children were engaged in greeting, introducing themselves, age, class year and their school. We are working on identifying all the Arabic letters and sounds to help us read words and use the pictures to understand the meaning.







Room 2: Year 1-2

In Room 2, we have been learning about ourselves. We learnt to greet, introduce ourselves, tell age, our class level and school. We also learnt about body parts, colors, clothes. We are learning to sound out, read short sentences and join letters together to write words.







Room 3: Year 2-3

In Room 3, we have focused on the correct way to pronounce the Arabic letters and connect them using the right shape to form words. We have also done recounts and descriptive writings about my best

friend, the pet shop and who am I.







Room 4: Year 3-4

In Room 4, we have been working on improving our writing as we have started to write longer paragraphs, using full stops and commas. We have written about the holidays, hobbies and best friend. Students wrote lots of good ideas and their writing is displayed on our walls.







Room 5: Year 4-5

Students in Room 5 started writing two paragraphs in Arabic using dictionary to add new words. They have done good writing talking about themselves, their hobbies and what they like and dislike. This week, they have been writing a letter to Christchurch expressing their feeling and sending affected families their thoughts and Dua's.
